

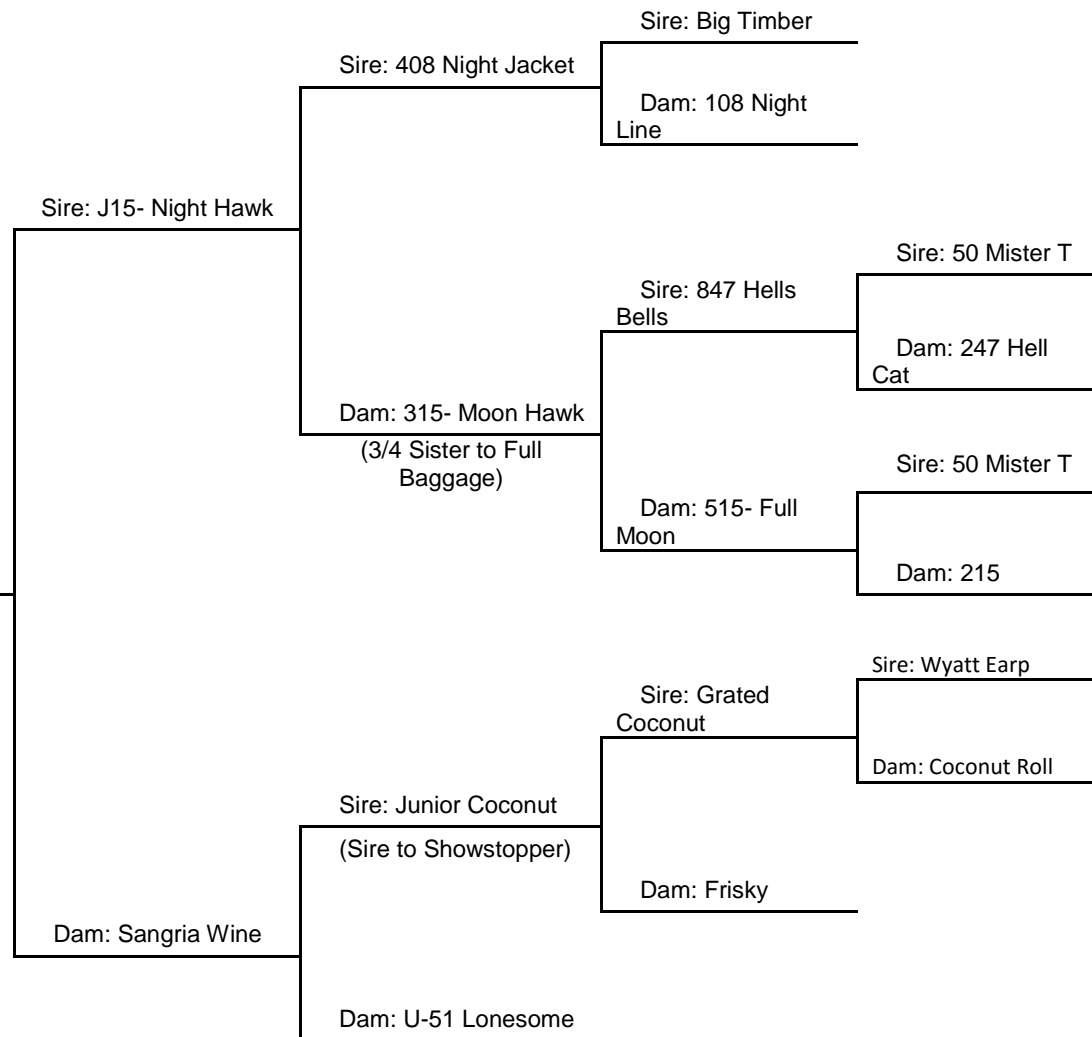
# Jackson 3 Farms Ltd.

All the mares in this sale have been exposed to Midnight Cowboy for 2 months. This colt combines the bloodlines of Full Baggage, Showstopper, Grated Coconut and Night Jacket. They were just 86 on his sire, Night Hawk in Stanford Mt where he was 22 on both sides. His dam is a buckin Jose with all the right style and motion, takes her head and stays right in front of the chute. This is a big, good bodied colt at only two years old and here is a chance to get into the line while it is still young.

This 7 year old mare is a  $\frac{3}{4}$  sister to Showstopper. Broken Lady is the mare responsible for a lot of Showstoppers style. Proven cross showing through one of the rankest horses in the world. This mare looks a lot like Showstopper but bigger. Good bodied, 15.2 and 1400 pounds. She is cripple in the hind end at a run and therefore does not have any rider trips, but is 100% at a walk and trot and throws a healthy colt every year. Similarities to Showstopper in her 2 year old video. This mare crossed with Midnight Cowboy will give you two doses of Showstopper and Grated Coconut along with Night Jacket and Full Baggage on the sire's side.

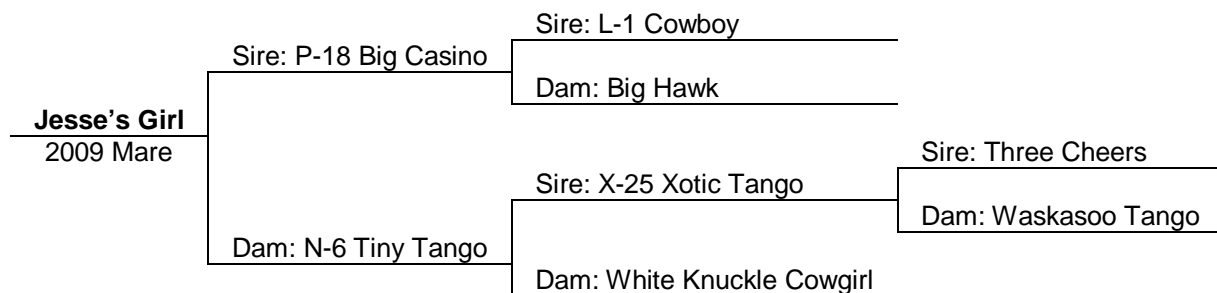
## Jesse's Girl

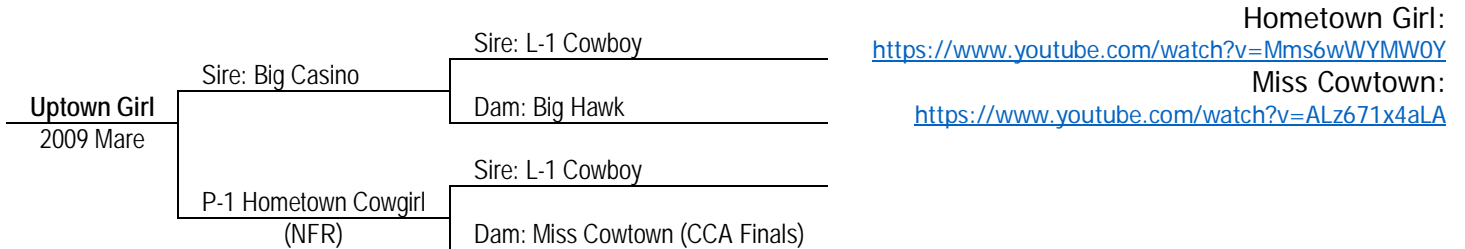




## Uptown Girl

7 yr old Black & White Paint Mare

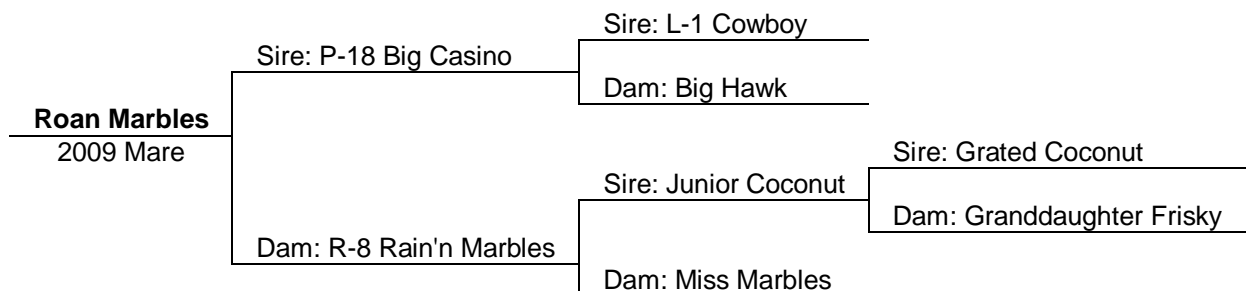

Hometown Girl is a 2X NFR mare and is still a 21 point horse. Her sire is a producer and a buckner and has been to the INFR several times. This mare has given us a few awesome colts including one by Straight Jacket and is now for sale



## Roan Marbles

Big Casino is a several time INFR horse. Roan Marbles has produced our strongest colts of the year from several different studs. Her colts by Big John and Night Hawk are showing immense potential. This mare is a proven producer.

Not much to say about this mare other than she is out of two great bucking horses and is now producing great bucking horses. Colored Marbles was one of the rankest horses on the ranch well into her teens and Cowboy Cowntown won horse of the RNCFR in Kissimmee and led Jacobs Crawley to a win at the cinch shootout in San Angelo this year. This mare, Marbles Mayhem has all the size and breeding and has a colt by Big John that is already proving to be a strong saddle bronc horse before the age of three. This line goes back to the many time NFR horse Marbles who was still winning rounds in Cheyenne into his 20's. Here is one of the favorites at the ranch.



## Whiskey Girl

Here is one of the best bred mares on the ranch, with the buck to back it up. Covergirl has progeny scattered from Northern Canada to Texas to Australia. Here is her colt, a good looking mare that has been bucked and produces good colts. We sold Covergirl as a part of a dispersal of the older broodmares and I made a point to buy her back from Texas a few years later. We now have her along with several new fillies from her and have decided to pass Whisky Girl along and give someone the chance to get these proven genetics in their own herd. Have a look at

## Dessert Cowtown

This 2009 mare is a maternal sister to Muffled Cries (2x NFR, 4x CFR) of Calgary's. In my own eyes, this mare is bred better than Muffled Cries herself and shows a lot of promise in the handful of rider trips she has had. This mare is stacked with one of the best producing granddams in the country on the sire's side and a proven NFR producer in Desert Sky. Cowboy Cowtown was sold to Pete Carr and won horse of the RNCFR in 2015. Her granddam, Miss Cowtown is a CCA finals mare and still bucking strong nearing her 20's. Dessert Cowtown kicks harder than most Cowboy horses and is bred to last.

Born 2002. Daughter of Desert Sky and sired by the late Wild Strawberry, one of the Calgary Stampede Ranch's prime herd sires in 80's and 90's and the father of many Stampede champion horses.

Muffled Cries has qualified many times for both the CFR and the NFR in her seven-year career to date. Muffled Cries is known for bucking high and hard, most recently carrying Stephen Dent to the pay window with an 89-point ride at the Innisfail Rodeo in June of this year. Dusty Lavalley hit 90 points aboard Muffled Cries at the Calgary Stampede in 2012 during the short round to place second overall.

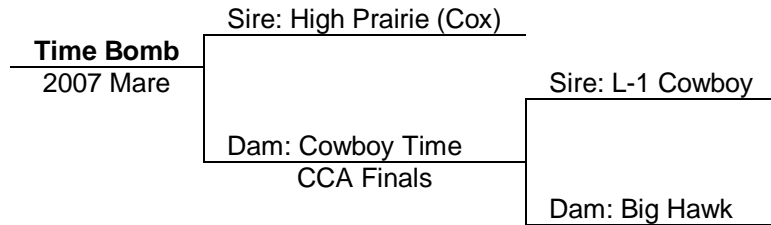
