
## JACKSON RODEO STOCK SALE



This sale is a once in a lifetime opportunity to buy into world champion Calgary Stampede foundation blood lines. The Jackson family has been raising rodeo stock for over 40 years, over 15 of which have been in cooperation with the Calgary Stampede's Born to Buck program. During this time the Jackson family has raised many world class bucking horses which were sold exclusively to the Calgary Stampede. The Jackson family has sold such brand name horses as Kerrigan Country (NFR), I See U (NFR), Super Sue (NFR), Cash Machine (NFR), Loganberry (NFR), Court Jester (CFR), and Marbles (NFR). This sale is the first time that Jackson Rodeo stock has been offered in a public auction.

The Jackson horses have been bred for confirmation, size, power, durability, athleticism, and a bucking style suitable for the short round. Most of the horses in this sale are descendents of several foundation stallions which the Jackson Family leased from the Calgary Stampede: Grated Coconut (5x World Champion Bareback Horse), Wildstrawberry (NFR), Cowboy, Xotic Tango, and Walleye Roan.

This sale includes 7 stallions, 11 brood mares and 29 bucking horses. The stallions embody the size and power characteristics that have made Jackson horses successful. Any one of these stallions will make an outstanding herd sire in a NFR caliber breeding program. The stallions include one son of Grated Coconut, two sons of Wildstrawberry, and three sons of Cowboy.

The 11 brood mares in the sale represent the core of the Jackson blood lines that have produced top quality NFR horses. They also stem from the same blood lines as the stallions (Grated Coconut, Wildstrawberry, Cowboy, Walleye Roan). Nine are pasture bred to Junior Coconut, a son of Grated Coconut and two are pasture bred to Big Casino, a son of Cowboy. This is a truly unique opportunity to buy a proven world class breeding program in one package.

The 29 bucking horses in this sale are an outstanding group at the start of their bucking career. They have the same blood lines as the stallions and brood mares and are of a size and age suitable for the rodeo circuit. 16 head are mares which can be used as either rodeo stock or brood mares.
