

471 Creek

Owner: Real Bird Ranch 5 yr old Mare Left Hand Delivery Bareback

Started bucking as a 3 yr old. Creek has about 18 trips. She weighs in at about 1275 lbs and stands about 15.3 hands. She is a nice big horse that can also take a pulling. Creek's sire is #77 Ike and her dam is a gray Kesler mare, #314. An added bonus: Creek is in foal to #JA3, an outstandin bucking horse stallion whose momma was an NFR qualifier named "Ridley One". #JA3's sire is also an NFR bronc named LV92, both offspring of the famous Boy Ballou of the equally famous Bob Barnes Rodeo Co. Creek has been tougher to make the whistle on than Jumano. Short round at all the major Indian rodeos. Not very rider friendly. Left

hand delivery and usually about 2 jumps, then to the left in a circle, and out to the center of the arena.



505 Pearly Gates

Owner: Real Bird Ranch 4 yr old Palomino Gelding Saddle Bronc

Pearly Gates is a palomino that stands about 15.2 hands and weighs about 1225 lbs. he was started as a 3 yr old has bucked 2 yrs with about 17 trips. His sire is #77 Ike and his momma is a Cox mare. Pearly Gates goes from a right hand delivery and has been in every short round at our rodeos. Jeremy Meeks, of Bates Land, SD, scored 89 pts on Pearly Gates to win Rocky Boy, MT, home of the "Chief of all Indian Rodeos."



C-34 Jumano

Owner: Real Bird Ranch 6 yr old Gelding Bareback

Started bucking as a 3 yr old. Has about 20 plus outs. Nice thick bodied horse that can take a pulling. Weighs bout 1200 lbs, about 15 hands high, great bone an feet. Jumano's sire is Ike #77. Ike is out of a stud by the name of "Stands alone", owned by Ike Peters of Northern Alberta. Jumano's dam is a Kesler mare who we purchased at the Kling sale about eight

yrs ago. Jumano is a short round type bucker at our rodeos. The bareback riders love to get on this horse and is rider friendly. He sticks to a pattern almost every trip. They have won almost all the big Indian rodeos on his back. Dale Stoller of Havre MT scored 91 pts on Jumano in Kalispell, MT at the Luke Warner Invitational match bronc riding, to win the bareback riding.
