Owner: Real Bird Ranch 6 yr old Dirty Buckskin Mare Right Hand Delivery Saddle Bronc

Abenaki is a dirty buckskin mare who has had about 20 plus outs. She was started as a 3 yr old. She weighs about 1150 lbs and stands about 15.1 hands high. Abenaki's sire is Tango and dam is a Franklin mare that we purchased at the Kling sale in New Town from Wes Janis of Pine Ridge, SD. She is also in foal to #JA3; an outstanding young sire we bought last year in the '08 Kling sale from Bob Barnes. Abenaki is also a short round saddle bronc. Nice to put a spur ride on. Nice rhythm and timing. She's really just a cowboy friendly horse. Usually goes right hand delivery and drifts out across the arena to the right. Rollin Wilson of Buffalo, SD spurred Abenaki to an 87

pt ride at the '08 INFR in Las Vegas to record the hi mark ride of the entire rodeo.

508 Sun Dog

Sun Dog is a nice young dun paint that stands about 1300 lbs. Sun Dog was started as a 3 yr old and has about 16 trips. He's sired by #77 Ike of our breeding program. Ike seems to be a good producer that throws some buck into his colts. Sun Dog's momma is a Kesler mare we purchased in New Town about 8 yrs ago. Sun Dog's first trip was with Guy Simanton who scored in the 80's on him. Sun Dog continues to buck in the short rounds at all our Indian rodeos and match bronc ridings. He is constantly in the 20 pt range. Sun Dog was the hi mark saddle bronc at the Luke Warner Invitational when he threw off J.T. Robbins of Montana, in an outstanding trip. He usually goes out right hand delivery and angles to the right, across the arena.
